

**EGG HARBOR TOWNSHIP RECREATION COMMISSION
MINUTES
DECEMBER 16, 2009**

Present: Fairfield, Fiedor, Davis, Gallagher, Hiller, Lincoln, Messina, Warrell, Williams and Rispoli.

Minutes: October 14, November 11 and December 2, 2009, approved.

Public:

- EHT Baseball.
New President, Tom Putney addressed the Commission. Rob Hickman was introduced as their maintenance coordinator. Field 6 is their only 50-70 field. They requested permission to convert field 4 to a 50-70 field. They were advised that Public Works maintains the fields and they would have to speak with Simerson, Canale or Shaw.

- U-10 Soccer.
William McGruder requested permission, for a waiver, to add one girl, from Mays Landing, to his U-10 travel team. He indicated that he is having a difficult time fielding the team with strictly EHT residents. His season opens on March 6, 2010. Indoor practices are slated to begin on December 30, 2009.
It was recommended that EHT Soccer send out emails to attempt to recruit Townships residents, prior to voting on a waiver. The waiver request was tabled until the January 2010 meeting.

- Recreation Commission meeting dates.
Doris Dilley inquired whether Recreation Commission meeting changes were posted and where she could find the changes. She was advised that announcements concerning meeting changes are listed on the ehtgov.org website and in the Current. She was also given the Recreation Department's phone number.

New Business:

- 2010 Recreation Commission meetings.

- Dog Park.
Survey will be placed on the EHTGOV.ORG website to ascertain whether EHT residents feel that a dog park is warranted.
- Repairs to Child-Kirk Park.
EHTYS President will meet with Public Works to discuss the needed repairs/improvements.
