### **Township Committee to recognize four individuals for their service to the governance of Egg Harbor Township.**

The Egg Harbor Township Committee has established a Citizen's Honor Roll to be located in the new Community Center, 5045 English Creek Avenue, as a way of recognizing dedicated service to the governance of Egg Harbor Township.

The Township Committee established this honor roll to provide recognition for service to Egg Harbor Township. Mayor McCullough said, "This is an outstanding way of recognizing those who have provided years of service to the governance of our fine community".

Deputy Mayor Glassey and Committeeman Carman helped design and build the Wall of Honor in the Community Center.

In order for an individual to be considered for recognition for the Citizen's Honor Roll, they must have provided 10 years of service to the Township as a Member of Township Committee or an appointed Board. In addition, they must have demonstrated involvement in other activities of the Community.

The inaugural inductees to the Citizen's Honor Roll are John Couchoud, Charles Canale, John "Lenny" Carman, Sr., and John Heinz. The Township Committee will be recognizing these individuals on Wednesday, July 8<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 p.m. in the Community Center. The Township Committee's regular meeting has been moved to the Community Center for this purpose.

John Couchoud (1903-1984) was a member of Township Committee from 1945 thru 1972. He served as Mayor of Egg Harbor Township from 1954 thru 1957 and again from 1959 thru 1961. Mr.

Couchoud was a charter member of the Egg Harbor Township Athletic Association, serving as its President in 1956 and 1957. In addition, he was a charter member of the Cardiff Volunteer Fire Company.

Charles Canale (1915-2006) was a member of Township Committee from 1961 thru 1978. He served as Mayor from 1962 thru 1971 and again from 1974 thru 1977. He served on the Planning Board from 1964 thru 1971 and again from 1974 thru 1977. He was a member of the Egg Harbor Township Municipal Utilities Authority from 1967 thru 1981. He was a charter member of the Bargaintown Fire Company in 1932, serving as a member thru to 1983. He was the Chief of the Fire Company from 1940 to 1983. He was a founding member of the Egg Harbor Township Youth Organization.

John "Lenny" Carman, Sr. (1937-1993) was a member of the Egg Harbor Township Board of Education from 1968 thru 1973. He served as a member of Township Committee from 1985 thru 1988. He served as a member of the Zoning Board of Adjustment from 1990 thru 1993. He was a charter member of the First District Ambulance Squad and served from 1963 thru 1970.

John Heinz served on Township Committee from 1978 thru 1983 and 1990 thru 1992. He was Mayor of Egg Harbor Township from 1978 thru 1982. Mr. Heinz served on the Zoning Board of Adjustment from 1995 thru to 2007, and as its chairman from 1997 thru 2007.

The Township is honored to install these four individuals as a first class of members to the Citizen's Honor Roll. Their legacy will be viewed and appreciated by many for years to come.
