## **Township Committee to recognize three individuals for their service to the governance of Egg Harbor Township.**

The Egg Harbor Township Committee has established a Citizen's Honor Roll in the Community Center, 5045 English Creek Avenue, as a way of recognizing dedicated service to the governance of Egg Harbor Township.

The Township Committee established this honor roll to provide recognition for service to Egg Harbor Township. Mayor McCullough said, "This is an outstanding way of recognizing those who have provided years of service to the governance of our fine community".

In order for an individual to be considered for recognition for the Citizen's Honor Roll, they must have provided 10 years of service to the Township as a Member of Township Committee or an appointed Board. In addition, they must have demonstrated involvement in other activities of the Community.

The inductees to the Citizen's Honor Roll are Nathan Davis, Jr., June Sheridan and Stanley "Jake" Glassey. The Township Committee will be recognizing these individuals on Wednesday, October 26th at 6:00 p.m. in the Community Center. The Township Committee's regular meeting has been moved to the Community Center for this purpose.

Mr. Glassey was a member of Township Committee from 2001 through 2010, as well as from 1981 to 1983. Mr. Glassey served as Mayor in 1983 and as Deputy Mayor from 2001 through 2010. Mr. Glassey has served on the EHT Municipal Utilities Authority continuously since 1983. He has been the MUA's Vice Chairman since 1985. Mr. Glassey was a member of the EHT Board of Education from 1984 to 1995. In addition, Mr. Glassey was a member of the South Jersey Transportation Authority from 1992 through 2005, serving as its Chairman from 1994 to 2005.

Mr. Davis has served on the EHT Municipal Utilities Authority since 1992. He held the position of Secretary from 1994 to 2001. He is currently serving as the Chairman of the MUA, a position he has held since 2001. Mr. Davis previously served on the EHT Board of Education from 1983 to 1996. He was the President of the Board from 1984 to 1996.

Mrs. Sheridan was a founding Director and President of the Greate Egg Harbor Township Historical Society in 1979 and continues to serve on the Board of Directors. For the past sixteen years, Mrs. Sheridan has served as the Township Historian. In 1998, she was appointed as the Atlantic County Historian and she is still currently serving in that position. In 2002, she was appointed to the Atlantic County Cultural and Heritage Advisory Board and in 2005 appointed Chairperson of the Board.

The Township is honored to install these three individuals to the Citizen's Honor Roll. Their legacy will be viewed and appreciated by many for years to come.
