The State of New Jersey is slowly opening. We will be moving into Stage 2 on June 15<sup>th</sup>. This will allow outdoor dining and limited in-person retail. The Township Committee advised our restaurateurs that outside dining will be permitted in the Township to assist these valuable businesses in restarting.

In April, we had one hundred forty-six (146) positive cases and eleven (11) deaths. In May, we had one hundred seven (107) positive cases and seven (7) deaths. We are trending in the right direction.

The State of New Jersey has experienced 160,918 positive cases and 11,721 deaths.

With the re-opening of our State, I highly recommend that residents continue wearing their mask when out, maintain proper social distancing and to wash your hands often.

As part of the re-opening of the State, Governor Murphy anticipates the opening of limited fitness/gyms to happen after June 22<sup>nd</sup>. Day summer camps are permitted to resume after July 6<sup>h</sup>. Our Parks and Recreation Department is currently developing a program to comply with the State Department of Health's guidelines for summer camps.
