The State of New Jersey has imposed a travel advisory on States that have a positive COVID-19 test rate higher than 10 per 100,000 residents or have a ten percent (10%) higher positive rate over a seven (7) day rolling average. Currently, there are twenty-two (22) States that have test rates higher than this standard. For a list of those States go to www.covid19.nj.gov.

In the past two (2) weeks, EHT has had thirty-eight (38) positive cases and one (1) death. I am optimistic that these declining trends will continue in our community. With organized sports allowed to play, I would ask that we continue to wear our masks at these events and practice social distancing whenever possible.

On Monday, July 20th the Municipal Building will reopen to the public. It was tentatively scheduled for this week, but it was pushed back one (1) week to insure all safety standards were in place for the public and employees. The building will be open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Anyone entering the building will be required to wear a mask that covers their mouth and nose.
