Dear Egg Harbor Township Residents:

The Atlantic County Health Department informed the Egg Harbor Township (EHT) Office of Emergency Management that three (3) of our residents has tested positive for the 2019 Novel Coronavirus. Our thoughts are with this resident and family.

The Health Department is currently working to conduct a thorough investigation to identify other individuals with whom the patient may have come in contact. Officials will then contact them in order to provide the necessary supports and guidance.

EHT is a strong community, but this confirmed case is a reminder to all that we are not immune to current public health concerns. However, all residents can make deliberate efforts to flatten the curve of virus transmission by practicing social distancing, changing higher-risk plans like using public transportation, traveling, and attending large gatherings. It is similarly important that those with questions seek appropriate guidance and medical care at the direction of primary care physicians.

Please continue to support one another during a challenging time for our local, state, and national communities. Be certain to follow recommendations from the Centers for Disease Control, the New Jersey Department of Health, and Atlantic County Health Department.
