

DIED – LACK OF MOTION TO INTRODUCE

Egg Harbor Township

Ordinance No. 7

2021

An ordinance to amend the Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, Chapter 165, entitled “Parks and Recreation Areas” specifically 165-6A entitled “Permits.”, as amended

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Egg Harbor, County of Atlantic and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1: Chapter 165 of the Code of the Township of Egg Harbor, Section 165-6A entitled “Permits” is hereby amended by deleting in its entirety and replacing as follows:

§165-6. Permits.

A. Permits for park(s) and recreation area(s) use are issued in priority order by category in which the organization or event is placed. A Category I user/event has priority over Category II, III and IV user/event, etc. Permits must be available for review at time of field use. Department of Parks and Recreation will make every reasonable effort to treat all organizations, teams, and individuals using Township facilities in a fair and equitable manner. All parties must comply with federal and state anti-discrimination laws. Permits for park(s) and recreation area(s) use are issued by priority as listed below and according to policies contained herein. Park(s) and recreation area(s) use permits should be carried by the permittee at all times, during scheduled use of the park(s) and recreation area(s) and must be presented upon request. These permits are nontransferable and may not be passed on to other user groups. All field users must adhere to their designated activity, times, locations and dates of assigned use. Authorized permits will only be distributed after all required documentation has been submitted. All organized sports, activities, and instruction, must have an authorized permit for use of Township athletic facilities. Permits are obtained through the Parks and Recreation Department.

SECTION 2: All ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are, to the extent of such inconsistency, hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: Should any section, clause, sentence, phrase or provision of this Ordinance be declared unconstitutional or invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon final adoption and publication according to law.
